

## DCMYC 2012 Season Standings, July through December, final results for 2012

RG-65 Race at Tingley on July 7, 2012, Race #12

Mike Jiron served as non-sailing RD and earned (2) points for season standings. Steve Bailey reported: We started at 1:00pm with very light winds making racing very challenging. After 1:30pm, the winds picked up and became gusty making racing difficult in a different way. The fleet took a break at 2:00 just as the rain started. It continued to rain throughout the break, but let up some when the break was over. The decision to continue racing was made after rain stopped, the wind gusts got so bad that racing had to be suspended for the day. The tie between Steve Bailey and Bob Jones was broken in Steve's favor since he had 2 third place finishes. DNF = DNS = Number of boats + 1 = 8.

Peter, Steve and Michael deployed a new permanent buoy before the racing began. It is a round foam filled buoy. It was stable as a rock Saturday even in the high winds. More will be deployed in the future until all buoys are permanent.

**Soling One Meter Race at Tingley on June 9, 2012, Race #9**

Pete Eschman served as non-sailing RD and earned (2) points for season standings. Peter Roupas was sailing his boat with a new keel (we were wondering what his boat weighs now that he is so fast! – I kid, of course). We were joined by new member Jay Eschenberg, who bought Ed Dzikczek's old Soling "Stinger", #596. Jay's big boat racing experience includes a J-24 he raced at Elephant Butte. Fendal Glenn experienced some rudder problems and was unable to sail most of the heats. Winds were quite variable and due to a shortage of only 4 operational marks, we sailed a windward/leeward course, heading north at the start, with port side rounding of the start/finish marks on the way to the south end of the pond. The loop around the start/finish marks added two so-called reaching legs, and mixed up finishes for some skippers. DNS = DNF = Number of boats + 1 = 7.

*December 2012 update: Peter Roupas later learned that his new keel removed weight from his boat, and that he was sailing a Soling that was 6 ounces lighter than the class minimum. We thank him for coming forward with this information, and have rescored him as Retired (RET) for the five events where this occurred. RET = Number of boats + 1, or last place for the events on June 9, June 23, July 28, August 11 and August 25 of 2012.*

## Soling One Meter Race at Tingley on December 8, 2012, Race #20

Earl Boebert served as non-sailing RD, but did not earn (2) points for season standings because he had already accrued this score twice this year. Winds were mostly light with some moderate gusts. We witnessed the first ever Goose to Soling Grudge Match, and the Soling was a clear loser. Two geese came in from the east for pond landings, one settled into the pond just astern of Bob Jones' Soling while he was running south before the wind. The second goose just plowed into Bob's rig, de-masted it, got tangled in the rigging and mostly sunk the boat. *Update: Bob Jones thinks that pair-bonded Canadian geese were taking off from the pond, and that the female was trying to keep up with her mate when she collided with the sail of his boat.* The goose made its way toward the east edge of the pond, towing the remainder of Bob's Soling behind it. The goose remained tangled in the rigging while bits of Bob's boat would surface from time to time. Bob walked to the east edge of the pond to try to retrieve the wreck.

A very kind bystander stripped down to his shorts and swam over to the goose and attached wreckage. He managed to free the goose and pull the remainder of Bob's boat to the shore. We want to thank Philip Runion for his kind deed, and have sent him a \$25 gift certificate to REI. Air and water temperatures were quite cold on the day of this event! Bob retrieved all but two hatch covers, and should be able to repair his boat. Bob was awarded a redress as specified in our Handbook, using his season average for heats he could not sail. Bob's season total is 81 for 19 events before discards, which results in a value of 4.2632 for each heat.

There are two sections of our DCMYC Handbook that deal with Redress. We have chosen to give Bob Jones the benefit of the second section of Redress shown below (5.4.2.1)

5.4.1.4 To encourage a member to loan his boat and coach another person during a heat or race, the member shall declare his intention to the RD and scorer, and may receive an average heat or race score in accordance with 5.4.2.1 Redress.

5.4.2.1 Redress. When a Right-Of-Way yacht is damaged or entangled sufficiently as to be unable to compete as the result of action by a burdened vessel, the ROW yacht shall be given points equal to its average finishing position during the other heats in that race, providing that said average is based upon at least three heats. Should the ROW yacht be unable to compete in three heats, then points shall be awarded at the end of the year based upon the average points for that year. Points shall be awarded for each heat during that race in which the ROW yacht was unable to participate.
