Pete Eschman served as sailing RD. Four of us enjoyed warm and sunny conditions at the pond. Winds were mostly moderate with some light spots, and ranged in direction from south to northwest. The first heat was sailed to the south, rounding SE yellow, S center orange, then north to NE yellow, N center orange then finish. All subsequent heats sailed south to the center orange, SE yellow, then north to NE yellow, N center orange then south to finish between the white buoys.

We took a break after the sixth heat, at which time Buzz felt he had enough. We raced one more heat before Peter R. had to leave at 2:15. John Clough and Peter Eschman then sailed three practice heats to round out the day.

The Bio Park did not provide the usual signage, post, and ropes we used in the past to restrict the public from walking through our area. Most of the public were wearing masks, so that helped a bit with the resulting traffic in front of us.

Light winds out of the NW or SE challenged us as they shifted frequently through every cardinal direction. The first heat was sailed to the NW green, NE yellow then to the finish line. The second and third heats were sailed to the SE yellow, SW green, north center orange then finish. Heats four through nine were sailed to the NW green, N center orange, SW green, S center orange then north to finish. Three of the four boats finished first in at least one heat. John Clough's first place in the last heat secured the tie break in his favor for second place in the event.

Race Director Bill Bank set a up an interesting course heading north to the NE yellow buoy port side turn, then to the green port side, thence to the West start buoy making a port-side turn, and thence to the East start buoy with a starboard-side turn, thence to the South Green Buoy to port and the South yellow buoy to port and north back to the finish line. Shifting gusty winds made for some interesting situations. John Clough got hung up n the north orange buoy when he was hit by a gust. The run from the west start buoy to the East start buoy resulted in some interesting jams. This was the first official DF 95 race of the 2021 series.
