### RG-65 Race at Tingley on February 2, 2013, Race #1

Our 2013 racing season finally got underway with this event. Ice on the pond in January caused us to pull the racing marks and cancel events that month. Temperatures were in the low 50s with a light wind.

Sebastian sailed his new boat, using Steve's (#67) rig, and did really well. Dane Christopher was RD for the first time and as non-sailing RD, he earned (2) points for our season standings.

Pete Eschman served as non-sailing RD and earned (2) points for season standings. Kathy Bailey served as scorekeeper. Temperatures were in the mid-50s with light winds that turned to moderate southerlies by midafternoon. Steve's boat suffered a series of breakdowns in its first shakedown event, so he was unable to finish the heat before our break, and did not sail afterwards. The tie for fourth between Dane and Earl was broken in Dane's favor since he had two third place finishes and Earl had just one.

**RG-65 Boat Swap Race at Tingley on March 30, 2013, Special Event 5<sup>th</sup> Saturday**

We took advantage of the fifth Saturday in March to hold a RG-65 Boat Swap event. We had seven skippers, so we sailed a total of seven heats. We sailed our own boat in the first heat, then sailed the next higher sail number in the next heat, wrapping around to the lowest number from highest number. Steve Bailey ran the races and Kathy Bailey helped score our special event. After the boat swap racing concluded, several skippers stayed on the pond for two fun races that were not scored. We scored the Skippers, Boats and combined Skipper+Boat score. I have shown the results in order of combined Skipper+Boat places.

Temperatures were warm and winds were typically moderate, with one heat sailed in gustier conditions. Everyone seemed to have a good time, and learned some about how the other boats sail. Pat's #131 was a particularly challenging boat to sail, because the rudder direction was reversed from that of all the other boats. Pat said this was only by accident, and that he planned to remedy the rudder direction setting. Some skippers who were used to standard rigs may have also experienced difficulties adapting to the swing rig balance and sailing characteristics, and the swing rig boats all seemed to have their own balance point. Because we scored in so many ways, most skippers can scrutinize the results and find something worthy of bragging rights!

Soling One Meter Race at Tingley on March 9, 2013, Race #2

Pete Eschman served as non-sailing RD and earned (2) points for season standings. Westerly winds were moderate, with occasional moments where the boats were a bit over-powered. It was difficult to set a good upwind leg, so we started heading north to the NW buoy, then port side roundings on the north buoys, followed by starboard side rounding of the SW buoy and remaining south buoys with somewhat of a beat to the finish. This course and wind direction made it nearly impossible to start on starboard. We would have needed to rotate the pond 90 degrees to accommodate the west winds we had for this event. With the breeze and temps in the 40s, folks were getting cold, so we called it quits at the break. DNF = Number of boats + 1 = 7.

Soling One Meter Race at Tingley on March 23, 2013, was cancelled due to high winds.



**Soling One Meter Race at Tingley on May 11, 2013, Race #5**

Jim Scheibner served as non-sailing RD and earned (2) points for season standings. We had a good turnout this day, and winds were mostly moderate, trending heavy at times. A few boats suffered breakdowns of various magnitudes during the event. A collision between Joel C' de Baca and Peter Roupas resulted in damage to Peter's boat. Since Peter's boat was the right of way boat, he was awarded redress for the remaining heats, while Joel was given a DSQ. Redress is the average of heat scores prior to the accident, which was  $35/8 = 5$  (redress is covered in section 5.4.2.1 of our DCMYC Handbook). Peter Roupas continued his experiments with a new mark design based on three PVC pipe cored foam pool noodles strapped together. We plan to phase in the new design as existing marks need replacement.

DNF = DF and DNS = DS = and DSQ = DQ = Number of boats + 1 = 9.

In heat 10, the finish between Bob Jones and Joey Winklepleck was missed because the RD was distracted by a nearby conversation. In this case, two fourth place finishes were awarded, and the fifth place finish was skipped. Skippers are reminded to avoid the area around the RD until all boats have finished. Remember, you can relocate, but the RD must stay on the line to record finishers. Also remember that the RD may request your help in keeping track of finishers, so stay sharp and pay attention after you finish.

Also remember that you need to stay away from the course side of the finish line after you finish. This means that if you finish from the South, you need to stay North of BOTH finish marks until all boats have finished, or the RD gives different instructions. This procedure is required so that the RD can track all boats that have yet to finish.

You finish by completely crossing the line, and stay on the finished side of the line. You may also finish as your bow crosses the line, then drop back on the course side of the line until you round the end of the line. Either way, you must clear the finish line (without touching a finish mark) to be a legal finisher.

The tie between Joey Winklepleck and Earl Boebert for second place was broken in Joey's favor, since he had one first place finish. We stopped racing just before 3:30 pm, when all 14 heats on the score sheet were completed. DNF = DF and DNS = DS = and DSQ = DQ = Number of boats + 1 = 9.
