The initial toss-in mark for the east end of the start line was moved south by the wind. Two marks were set at the north end of the pond and one mark set south. There was no control zone restriction but all skippers remained within the typically restricted area limits. RG-65 Race at Tingley on February 7, 2015, Race #3

Pete Eschman served as non-sailing RD earning (2) points for season standings. The race day started slow—the RD needed a quick return trip home to retrieve the racing marks. Next, one of the toss-in marks was tossed-in including the retrieving line. The decision was made to recover the mark after the racing. The starting line was set at the pond center with two north marks and one south. Initial sailing instructions were for a start north; port rounding of the north marks; south to a port rounding of the south mark; finish north. Early heats were sailed in light, variable wind. The start direction was swapped between north and south multiple times. With the variable wind, either a poor start could be overcome or a great start erased. The wind increased significantly after the break causing some submarining downwind and occasional control problems. The last three heats were extended to two laps of the course. The delightful racing day in spring-like 60° plus weather ended with retrieving the toss-in marks (Peter R. and Jim S. retrieved the loose mark). Jim Mickelson won the tie-break with his second place finish when results are listed following the RRS section A8.1.

#### RG-65 Race at Tingley on February 21, 2015, Race #4

Jim Mickelson served as non-sailing RD earning (2) points for season standings. Toss-in marks were used to set the starting line at the pond center with two north marks and one south. Initial sailing instructions were for a start south; port rounding of the south mark; north to a port rounding of the north marks; finish south. Later heats were shifted to a north start to accommodate a wind shift. There was good wind with sudden shifts in gusts measured over 15 MPH. While Kieth dominated the first place finish position there was very competitive racing. Buzz and Mike were tied for third before considering throw outs. The RD was frequently challenged to record results with half the fleet finishing within a boat length of each other. Skipper ability to sail a steady course was constantly challenged by the strong wind. Increasing wind during the day resulted in boats submarining (the hull totally submerged momentarily on one Dragon Force) on the downwind leg. The east end of the start line was favored and frequently congested with the crowding continuing at the windward mark. The longer legs were sailed on a reach and the lighter wind periods freshened from behind to bunch the fleet for additional exciting mark rounding.
