## RG-65 Race at Tingley on January 6, 2018, Race #1

The first race of 2018 had a good turnout with eight boats starting the first four heats. A ninth boat arrived just before our break, but never got to race, as we had decided to call it a day because of lack of wind. John Clough performed the RD duties for his first time, earning (2) points as a non-sailing RD. The first race of the day had a downwind start going north with a port turn around red, and then south, but not going through the start marks with a port turn around the south green mark finishing to the north. Heat 2, 3 & 4 had a southerly start with port turns at green and yellow, followed by a gate at the white marks (skipper choice – port around the close white, or starboard around the far white), and then a port turn and the south yellow with a finish to the north. Some of the newer sailors had problems with the concept of the “gate”, but we’ll get that straightened out as the season progresses. ## RG-65 Race at Tingley on January 20, 2018, Race #2

Pete Eschman served as the non-sailing RD and earned a fleet finish score of (5). We had light to moderate winds, which were quite variable in direction. Wind speed seemed to pick up as the racing continued. Racing started by heading north with starboard roundings of the NW Green, Center Yellow, then south to a starboard rounding of the SE Red, then finish heading north. Skippers were confounded by unpredictable shifts when rounding the last mark of the course. Bill's boat quit working just before the start of heat 6. We took our break after the conclusion of heat 6, and it took a while to nurse Bill's boat back to shore. After the break we sailed two more heats, then called it quits when Lloyd's boat began to give him problems. Mark and Earl tied for first place in heat three; since the finish was too close to call. Both were awarded 1.5 points (the average of 1 + 2 = 3, then 3 / 2 = 1.5) for this heat. **DS (Did Not Start) = Number of boats + 1 = 5**

Peter Roupas served as a non-sailing RD earning a finish position of (2). The day started out with a breeze out of a northerly direction at about 3kt. There were six boats at the start, with a seventh arriving just before the break. Initial sailing instructions for the first two heats were to start toward the north at the white buoys, with port turns at red then green before sailing south to two more port turns at green and red, with a finish to the north. The remaining heats were basically the same, but on the south bound leg the far white buoy had to be taken on the boats starboard side. ### RG-65 Race at Tingley on March 3, 2018, Race #5

Mark Sutton served as a non-sailing RD for the first time earning a (2) point credit, as there were more than six boats present. The breeze was from the SSW at variable speeds. All heats were started between the white marks to the south. Heats 1 to 5 had port turn around both green and yellow mark, before sailing north for port turns around yellow and green, with a finish to the south. Heats 6 and 7 only had port turn at the south mark with the finish to the north. Heat #7 also saw Earl fouled at the start by another boat sufficient for "*a claim or possibility that a boat's score or place in a race or series has been or may be, through no fault of her own, made significantly worse by the action of a boat.*" The semi-official scorer implemented a redress following rules 62.1, 64.2, Appendix A10(b). Heats 8 to 10 went back to a full lap. We had several spectators inquire about the club, perhaps this will lead to a new member or two. **DF (Did Not Finish); DS (Did Not Start) = Number of boats + 1 = 7**

Of the boat that competed, three were RG65's and two DF65's. The wind was mostly out of a northerly direction, and of variable speeds. Just before the start of one heat, the wind switched to a southerly direction, so we had a downwind start. All heats started between the white marks. The first three heats had the boats going north to starboard turns around the green and red marks. Then in a southwest direction to a port rounding of the close white mark before heading to a starboard turn around the south red. We were then directed to a starboard turn around the north green mark before heading to a southerly finish between the white marks. Heats four through eight started to the north with starboard rounding of the green and red marks, sail south to starboard rounding's of the red and green marks, with a finish to the north. The lunch break last for 45 minutes, as the other skippers waited as Gifford went through the process of selling the club DF65 to our new member Rio Prorok.

We had a fair turnout for today's race. There were seven boats including the RD, but only 6 were allowed to sail as the RD is not allowed to sail if there are more than 5 boats. Allen "Buzz" Buzzell was the RD for the day earning the customary (2) for being the RD. Of the six that sailed, two were RG's and four were DF's. Heats #1 thru #4 started to the north between the white marks with a starboard rounding of the yellow mark. We were then instructed to sail south keeping the close white mark to port, then a starboard rounding of the south yellow, before heading north to starboard green and yellow. And then for something different, we sailed south to finish between the southern green and yellow marks. Heats #5 thru #7 started to the north between the white marks with starboard rounding of the red and yellow marks, with a finish to the south at the start/finish line. Heat #8 was the same start as heat #5, but the course was extended to include a starboard rounding of the south yellow before finishing to the north between the white marks. The light wind generated very slow racing. The only excitement was provided by heat #3 finish when Pete and Mark were separated by a bow bumper.
