S1M Race at Tingley on July 11, 2020

We cancelled the Soling event for 11-July because we didn't have enough boats to get three on the race course. Many folks are not willing to try to race in the hot July temps we are experiencing, especially when we will all need to wear a mask.

We are optimistic that we may be able to race 25-July, and will continue to try in August.

As a result, all DCMYC members are welcome at the pond on Saturday, but Earl wants me to remind you that he says temps are predicted to reach a high of 107 on Saturday, so plan accordingly.

RG-65 Race at Tingley on July 18, 2020,

Winds ranged from very light to moderate with direction periodically shifting between southwest and southeast. Peter Eschman served as sailing RD and earned a fleet finish of 2nd place. Temperatures were on the toasty to well-done side. Earl provided a shade shelter which helped make the heat more bearable.

The first heat was sailed starting south, then southwest green, southeast yellow then finish, with all marks to port. Subsequent heats started with the same first two marks, but added rounding the east white mark to port, then southwest green, then south center orange, then finish. We took a 5 minute hydration breaks between each heat, and sailed straight through, with no lunch break. Mark and Pete sailed DF-65 class while the others sailed within the umbrellaRG-65 class.

Greg Kelly sailed his DF-95 along with us for the first few heats, and was careful to avoid interfering with anyone who was officially racing. After six heats, three folks had had enough, so official racing stopped at that point. After discarding one worst finish, Bill and Pete were tied on points for first place, but Bill won the tie-break to sew up a first for the event. Kieth and Pete sailed two more practice heats with each finishing first in one of the two heats. Those heats took us to the 2 PM event finish time.

Three Solings raced today. We had moderate to light winds, predominately out of the southeast. This time Peter Roupas was sitting closest to the start line so he let us know if anyone was over early. We took turns calling finishes with a disinterested party watching any close calls. All but one heat was sailed by starting south, then rounding the SW green, center orange, and SE yellow marks to port, then finishing between the white marks. On the third heat, we started north to port roundings on the NE yellow, center orange, NW green and then finish.

We managed to avoid the submerged object on our third heat, however I did manage to discover it while sailing prior to the start of another heat. It is located roughly on a line from the south shade support on the picnic table to a low tree on the NW perimeter of the pond. In east/west terms, it would be between the NW green and center orange marks, but would be about 50 feet north of the west white starting mark. It is in the same place where we hit it several weeks ago, so it does not seem to be moving.

As in the previous Soling event on 12-September, Pete Eschman served scorekeeper and we voted on courses and scheduling as a group.
